Home Build Program

Door County Habitat for Humanity seeks home build partners!

- Habitat partners with individuals and families from application through construction and beyond
- Homes are built to meet the needs of the Future Homeowner
- Volunteers build the home, then the Homeowner purchases it from Door County Habitat for Humanity
- Partner families choose what community in Door County they wish to live in
- Homes are built to be safe, affordable, and energy efficient
- The community benefits from an increase in tax revenue and more affordable housing

Program Requirements

- At least 18 years old
- Have lived in Door County for entire 12 month period before applying
- Family Income at or below 60% of median income (see chart below)
- Unable to own your current home (exception: mobile homes)
- Unable to obtain conventional home loan
- Able to make monthly mortgage and escrow payments
- At least one-year continuous history of stable income
- \$500 earnest money when signing the building agreement
- Current home inadequate or substandard (overcrowded, physically deteriorated, unsafe, temporary)

Home Repair Program

For people who own their home but cannot afford to make repairs

- Critical repair, landscaping, and painting projects target existing homes
- Applicants must demonstrate both need and the ability to repay project costs (materials, permits, equipment, etc.)
- To find out if you are eligible, fill out an application and supporting paperwork. You may be our next Home Repair Partner!

We'll build a ramp, do safety repairs, paint or winterize your home.

Program Requirements

- Have lived in Door County for entire 12 month period before applying
- Family Income at or below 60% of median income (see chart below)
- Must own your home and provide proof of homeowner's insurance
- Willing to complete sweat equity hours

Homeowners reimburse Habitat for project costs, such as materials, permits, equipment rentals, and dumpsters. Payment Schedules are tailored to homeowners circumstances and possibly spread out over months or years.

Deconstruct

Habitat offers home deconstruction services for your home renovation or teardown.

- Habitat will remove reusable materials: cabinets, lighting fixtures, plumbing fixtures, appliances, wood paneling, siding, doors, and trim.
- Items sold in the ReStore raise money for new home construction and home repairs!
- Free service is provided at no cost to you!
- Save money on your project, keep useful items in use (not in landfills), and help your community provide affordable housing!

Pick Up

Pick-up service is available for donations.

- Deconstruction Project Pick Up: Free in Door County (excluding Washington Island).
- Other donation pick ups: \$20 in Door County (excluding Washington Island).

Delivery is also available for purchases from the ReStore

- Within Sturgeon Bay for \$25/trip
- Door County delivery is available for \$45/trip



Ramp Up!

Ramp Up Door County installs and leases emergency or temporary aluminum ramps to keep residents with a physical and financial need in their homes longer.

The ramp is leased for \$80 per month. When no longer needed, the ramps cycle back to Habitat for another person. This lowers costs to the homeowner and enables more Door County residents to safely access and stay in their homes throughout an illness or rehabilitation period.
